## Vishukra Prana Harana Vārāhī Virya Nandita

Śrī Vārāhī Devī is the irresistible force that destroys the lack of Virya (valour) in you. She gives the strength to overcome the weaknesses. She is called Dandanātha or Commander-in-Chief of the armed forces of Supreme Empress Lalitā Devī.

Knowing that Śrī Vārāhī Devī is with us, is our greatest strength in these unusually trying times.

Vārāhī Navarātri - is being celebrated from July 6th to 15th, 2024.

As health and well-being is a global imperative now more than ever, we have included special pocket friendly Aṣṭa Māṭrkā Abhiṣekam and Homam by remote participation.

1. Daily Vārāhī Mantra Japam and Homam with Dashamsam of Mantra Japam (including

Aṅga, Upāṅga, and Pratyāṅga devatās)

2. Abhiṣekam with 10 Litres of Milk or 2 Litres of milk to the Vārāhī Aṣṭa Mātrikā (Khadgamālā Devī) residing in the Śrī Yantra Maha Meru of Devipuram, with Vārāhī Mūla Mantram and Śoḍaśa Upacāra Pūjā
3. Abhiṣekam to the Utsavamurthy and Kumkum pūjā with Vārāhī Ashtottaram
4. Vārāhī Yantra Pūjā - daily

### **Upāsakas**

We request Sādhakas to do the Japa of Vārāhī Devī along with mantras of Her Aṅga, Upāṅga, and Pratyāṅga Devatās, at the comfort of your home and contribute the count to the Vārāhī Homam performed every night during the Navarātri .

# About Vārāhī Devī and Navarātri



## What is Navarātri?

Āṣāḍha Navarātri, also known as Gupta Navarātri or Vārāhī Navarātri, is a 9-day festival dedicated to Goddess Vārāhī Devī usually observed in June-July. These are very auspicious days to perform sādhana and also for any other specific pūjā to resolve the materialistic problems. By chanting shlokas and mantras, the devotees show their regard for the Goddess. It is believed that during Navarātri, the Goddess promptly heeds to devotees and fulfill their wishes. She is worshiped in the three forms of the divine femininity, as the remover of vices, as the bestower of wealth and prosperity, and as the Goddess of Wisdom.

## Who is Goddess Vārāhī:

The Goddess Vārāhī is one of the major deities in the Śrī Vidyā tradition. With the face of a boar, Vārāhī is worshiped by all the three major schools of Hinduism: Śaktism (Goddess worship); Śaivism (followers of the god Śiva); and Vaiṣṇavism (devotion to Viṣṇu). She is usually worshiped at night.

## Manifestations of Vārāhī in various scriptures:

Even though Vārāhī is described in many different forms, holding numerous weapons in various hands, in the Tradition of Śrī Vidyā, She is described as:

The one who sits on a lotus, dark as a rain bearing cloud, with curved canine teeth, three red eyes, vessel-like breasts heavy with milk. The one who generously gives boons, holds weapons from top right hand downwards: discus, sword, pestle, dispels fear; similarly, from left top down: conch, shield, plough, gives boons.

## Major manifestations of Vārāhī:

**1. Vārāhī Devī as described in Bhāgavata Purāṇa:** She's the feminine energy and also consort) of Varāha, the third of the 10 Avatars of the god Viṣṇu with the face of a boar. He is most commonly associated with the legend of lifting the Earth (personified as the goddess Bhūdevī) out of the cosmic ocean. When the demon Hiranyākṣa stole the earth and hid her in the primordial waters, Viṣṇu appeared as Varāha to rescue her. Varāha slew the demon and retrieved the Earth from the ocean, lifting it on his tusks, and restored Bhūdevī to her place in the universe.



**2. Vārāhī Devī as described in Brahmāṇḍa Purāṇa:** In Śrī Vidyā, Vārāhī, who is also called Daṇḍanāthā, is the Commander-in-Chief of all forces under Śrī Lalitā Mahā Tripurāsundarī. She was born from the flowery arrows of Śrī Lalitā, and represents ahamkāra tattva, or the element of the ego. Vārāhī is the most ferocious manifestation and aspect of Śrī Mātā (Mother), she destroys evil forces that obstructs the devotees' progress and paralyses the internal enemies.

As per the Lalitopākhyāna, Vārāhī emerged to kill Viśukra (Commander-in-Chief of demon Bhandāsura). Vārāhī's chariot is Kiri Chakra in which are seated the celestial physicians the Ashwini Devas and Śrī Dhanvantari - the God of Physicians (the father of Ayurvedic medicine). With celestial beings as these in Her chariot, bhaktas are blessed by Her with good health and relief from dreadful chronic diseases.

She is called Daṇḍanāthā (who carries the staff/cane), so that she goads the Sādhakas (practitioners) in right path. She is always ready to strike down and correct our path, whenever we go astray. She paves the way towards all our goals and helps us achieve the highest levels of spirituality as well as material success. Her boar face indicates that She can dig deep into our karmas and remove all the hurdles affecting our success in all matters. No one who seeks Her blessings and surrenders unto Her, will go empty handed. Such is Her greatness!



Rājasyamala and Vārāhī are the main pair of deities associated with Lalitā. While Rājaśyāmalā represents the female side, cooling moon or idā nādī and the five downward triangles in the Śrī Cakra, Vārāhī represents the male side, sun energy or pingala nādī and the four upward triangles in the Śrī Cakra.

**3. Vārāhī Devī as described in Mārkaṇḍeya Purāṇa:** Vārāhī is also the fifth among the eight mother Devis or Aṣṭamātṛkās. Hence also called Pañcami. According to Devī Mahātmya, Goddess Durgā created Mātṛkās from Herself and with their help slaughtered the demon army. As Aṣṭamātṛkā, Vārāhī represents the controlled energy of courage and fearlessness when these virtues go out of control and envy, greed and lust is the order of the day. As such Mother Vārāhī reminds us that we should be bold enough to take up any issue head on. Meditating and worshiping her reminds us of this truth.



### **Benefits of worshipping Vārāhī:**

She offers her diamond cage protection to the upāsakas of Śrī Vidyā. She is extremely powerful and invoking Her grace, is to utilize tremendous force against enemies for protecting one's own life or that of close family and friends from near death situations, deep debt, chronic diseases, unfair competition and huge business losses forcing closure or bankruptcy, etc.

### **Benefits in a nutshell:**

**Spiritual:** Protects and guides the Sādhakas, helping them shed their ego and realising their true nature, Protects From Enemies (Internal and External). She is the One who bestows the Ājñā or command to the Sādhaka to reach the Sahasrāra.

**Physical:** Bestows good health, cures chronic ailments and diseases, Provides Strength, Energy and Focus, Gives Wisdom and provides peace of mind, helps overcome land related problems

# Recommendations



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## FOR BHĀKTAS AND BEGINNERS

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For the seekers who want to worship Vārāhī during this coming Navarātri, but who have not been initiated into Her mūlamantra we can suggest the following modes of practice:

- **Worship:** Vārāhī Abhiṣekam with the Aṣṭa Māṭrkā Mantra
- **Chant:** Vārāhī Gāyatrī Mantra
- **Meditate on Her Attributes:** The 12 Names of Vārāhī or The 108 Names of Vārāhī
- **Be Protected:** Vārāhī Kavacam

These practices are given later in the course. Depending on your circumstances, you can either take up one of the above mentioned options or perform all of them, if you so desire and the time permits. It is advisable to undertake her sādhana in the evening, after 18:00.

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## FOR SĀDHAKAS

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If you have been initiated in Vārāhī mūlamantra, below are some of the options which you can utilize for your worship. Depending on your circumstances, you can either take up one of the below mentioned options or perform all of them, if you so desire and the time permits.

It is advisable to undertake her sādhana in the evening, after 18:00.

- **Worship:** Vārāhī Abhiṣekam, Vārāhī Yantra Pūjā, or Vārāhī Homa.
- **Chant:** Vārāhī Mūlamantra Japa with Aṅga, Upāṅga, and Pratyāṅga Devata mantras
- **Meditate upon Her attributes:** Vārāhī 108 Names or Vārāhī Sahasranāma
- **Be Protected:** Vārāhī Kavacam

As an example, you can commit to perform a certain number of japa per day, and on the final day of Navarātri perform a homa with total number of offerings equal to 10% of the amount of japa you have done.

*Kavacam means armor and its purpose is to protect and defend the body of the practitioner from all the directions.*

asya śīvārāhīkavacasya trilocana ṛṣīḥ | anuṣṭupchandah |

*This kavacam or shield of Śrī Vārāhī, may be used for the elimination of all enemies, internal and external. The sage/seer/ṛṣīḥ is Trilocana. The deity is Śrī Vārāhī, The seed/bija mantra is om. The power or śakti is glaum. The key/kilaka to unlock the kavacam is svāhā.*

**dhyānam (meditation)**

dhyātvendra nīlavarnābhām candrasūryāgni locanām |  
vidhiviṣnuharendrādi māṭrbhairavasevitām || 1 ||

*Let us meditate upon the Divine Mother Śrī Vārāhī, Who is dark blue in complexion and whose eyes are illumined with the energies of billions of suns, moons and fire. She is ardently worshipped by Lord Brahma the Creator, Lord Viṣṇu the Preserver, Lord Bhairava the Destroyer and all the celestial gods and other Māṭrkā-s and various forms of the Divine Mother Śakti.*

jvalanmaṇigaṇaprokta makuṭāmāvilambitām |  
astrāstraṇī sarvāṇī tattatkāryocitāni ca || 2 ||

*Precious and luminescent gems shine and droop forth from Her crown. She is ever ready with all Her most destructive weapons, to immediately accomplish any noble task at hand.*

etaissamastairvividham bibhratīm musalam halam |  
pātvā hiṁsrān hi kavacam bhuktimukti phalapradam || 3 ||

*She storms in with all Her enormous and extremely destructive weapons, consisting of a pestle (club or mace) and a plough, to completely annihilate all evil. This kavacam can provide salvation, as well as fulfillment of all material and spiritual wishes, to all the sincere worshippers of Śrī Vārāhī.*

## Beginning of the Kavacam

paṭhetrisandhyāṁ rakṣārthaṁ ghorāśatrūnivṛttidām |  
vārtālī me śirah pātu ghorāhī phālamuttamam || 4 ||

*Those who devotedly recite the kavacam three times a day at dawn, noon and dusk, will surely get protection against all enemies, internal and external. No matter how fierce the enemies may be, One will be blessed with the power to annihilate them. No harm shall befall the sincere devotees of Śrī Vārāhī.*

Vārtālī, the divine messenger, who warns us of all impending difficulties, protects the head and shields us from all danger. Her blessings are bountiful and everlasting! The forehead is protected by ghorāhī, the fiercest and terrific form of devi, who terrorizes the enemies and annihilates them.

netre varāhavadanā pātu karṇau tathāñjanī |  
ghrāṇāṁ me rundhinī pātu mukham me pātu jandhinī || 5 ||

*The boar faced Varāhavadanā protects the eyes and the ears are protected by the fabulous serpentine Tathāñjanī. The nose is protected by the ever blocking Rundhini. The Face is always protected by the Virtuous Jandhinī.*

pātu me mohinī jihvāṁ stambhinī kanthamādarāt |  
skandhau me pañcamī pātu bhujau mahiṣavāhanā || 6 ||

*The tongue is protected by the mesmerizing Mohinī, while Stambhinī, the One who stalls the enemies on their path, fervently guards the throat. The shoulders are protected by Pañcamī, The Re-creator of the Universe. The upper arms are always protected by Mahiṣavāhanā, the One who rides the bull and tames our ego.*

simhārūḍhā karau pātu kucau kṛṣṇamṛgāñcitā |  
nābhim ca śaṅkhinī pātu prsthadeśe tu cakriṇi || 7 ||

*Simhārūḍhā, the One who rides a lion and is fearless, protects the lower arms. The breasts are protected by Kṛṣṇamṛgāñcitā, the dark complexioned, boar faced and highly revered One. The navel region is protected by the Conch wielding Śaṅkhinī and the back portion of the body is protected by the disc wielding Cakriṇi.*

khaḍgam pātu ca kaṭyāṁ me medhram pātu ca khedinī |  
gudam me krodhinī pātu jaghanāṁ stambhinī tathā || 8 ||

*The sword wielding Khadginī protects the hips. The reproductive organs are protected by the piercing Khedinī. The anal region is protected by Krodhinī. The buttocks are always protected by the staller Stambhinī.*

caṇḍoccaṇḍaścoruyugam jānunī śatrumardinī |  
jaṅghādvayam bhadrakālī mahākālī ca gulphayo || 9 ||

*Both the thighs are protected by the fierce Caṇḍoccaṇḍa and the Knees are fiercely protected by Śatrumardinī. Both the shanks are protected at all times by the fiercest Bhadrakālī. The ankles are protected by the terrific Mahākālī at all times.*

pādādyāṅguliparyantam pātu commattabhairavī |  
sarvāṅgam me sadā pātu kālasaṅkarṣanī tathā || 10 ||

*The Feet and the toes are protected fervently by the blissful Unmattabhairavi at all times. All the body parts are protected by the dark and most attractive Kālasaṅkarṣanī.*

Phalaśruti (benefits of the reciting this kavacam)

yuktāyuktā sthitam nityam sarvapāpātpramucyate |  
sarve samarthyā samyuktam bhaktarakṣaṇatparam || 11 ||

*Whether one is in unison with Śrī Vārāhī in Her devotion or not a devotee of Her, All one requires is a fixation on Her, to become completely liberated from all sins and worries. She is always ready and prepared, to come to the rescue of Her devotees in distress.*

samastadevatā sarvam savyam viṣṇoh purārdhane |  
sarśāśatruvināśaya śūlinā nirmitam purā || 12 ||

*All celestial gods along with the Preserver Lord Viṣṇu, constitute half the power and She alone standing firm becomes another half, to withstand and destroy all enemies.*

sarvabhaktajanāśritya sarvavidveṣa sam̄hatih |  
vārāhī kavacam nityam trisandhyam yaḥ paṭhennarah || 13 ||

*For the welfare of all devotees and all beings, for the removal of all hatred between each other and for ensuring good bonding amongst all, Śrī Vārāhī kavacam must be recited thrice daily at dawn, noon and dusk.*

tathāvidham bhūtagaṇā na sprśanti kadācana |  
āpadaśśatrucorādi grahadoṣāscā sambhavāḥ || 14 ||

*Those who follow this procedure will soon get rid of all evil spirits, ghosts and bad influences impacting their peace of mind. No bad influence or evil karmic actions will dare to affect the devotees at any time. One need not fear from enemies, thieves, malefic planetary influences manifesting upon the sincere devotees.*

mātāputram yathā vatsam dhenuḥ pakṣmeva locanam |  
tathāṅgameva vārāhī rakṣā rakṣāti sarvadā || 15 ||

*Parents, children and all dear ones are protected at all times. The Divine Mother Śrī Vārāhī, will also bestow Her divine grace and immense protection on pets, farm animals, cows, calves and on all our possessions, at all times. There will be immense prosperity and abundance of material and spiritual riches.*

The meanings of the 12 names are:

1. **Pañcamī:** The fifth Devi, she is the fifth of the eight Matṛka Devis, also she is the power behind Sadaśiva the fifth Karaneśvara as his Anugraha (Divine grace) śakti.
2. **Daṇḍanāthā:** Commander in Chief of the armed forces of Śrī Lalita
3. **Saṅketā:** Secret coded, being in the army has secret codes
4. **Samayeśvarī:** Lord of the path where there are rules and restrictions.

5. **Samayasāṅketā:** secret code in the pūjā path, since pūjā is the sadhana and battle personified we have to understand the meaning and the philosophy behind every act in the pūjā, she confers on us this understanding.
6. **Vārāhī:** the divine power behind the Varaha avatar of Śrī Viṣṇu, who lifted the world from the sea, hence a huge form is indicated here
7. **Potriṇī:** boar faced. Since boar has an ability to float and swim in waters, she has the ability to keep her devotees afloat and steer them in the world.
8. **Śivā:** Ever auspicious. Since Devi is ever pure awareness she is ever auspicious.
9. **Vārtālī:** Lord of speech. As seen above the Varaha avatar used the tusks to lift the world, having big tusks are indicated here. Philosophically they indicate the Vedas which are the sure means for being lifted up.
10. **Mahāsenā:** Having great army. The body with flesh, bones, blood are her armies, so maintaining this body in good condition which is the boon of this Devi is indicated here.
11. **Ājñā cakreśvarī:** Lord of the ājñā cakra (mid eyebrow). All individual effort will be up the sadhaka to raise the Kundalini up to ājñā cakra, here the ājñā – the order of the Devi is required to move further to the Sahsarara, which is the grace of the divine mother through the Śrī Guru.
12. **Arighnī:** the remover of the enemies.

# Abhiṣekam to Vārāhī



## Guidelines for Abhiṣekam

Śrī Cakra consists of 9 Āvaraṇas (levels) and is the abode of 108 Śaktis. The first Āvaraṇa (the Bhupura square), contains 28 goddesses, 8 of which are Aṣṭamāṭṛkas.



## For those who want to worship Śrī Vārāhī Devī in Śrī Cakra

- In Śrī Cakra we recite the mantra to worship Goddess Vārāhī (9, 27, 54 or 108 times) and after each mantra recitation we pour the pañcamṛta (or milk) with a spoon at the corner where Vārāhī Devī resides.
- The mantra contains the Āvaraṇa mantra “**am̄ am̄ sauḥ**” followed by the name of the Goddess Vārāhī (“Vārāhi”) and Her nature, like “**mada nāśinyai**” (the one who helps you overcome pride), ending with “**namah**” (I bow to Her).

## For those seeking material benefit


- For someone seeing a particular material result, one can make a corresponding saṅkalpa and worship that Goddess by performing abhiṣekam with Her mantra 108 times for 44 days.
- Vārāhī Navarātri is the most favourable and opportune time to start this ritual and continue for 44 days.

## Material Benefit Ritual for an Uninitiate

1. Sit facing East.
2. For a few minutes meditate on a photograph of Guruji.
3. Recite:
  - (3 times) **Om Śrī Gurubhyo Namah**, after that
  - (3 times) **Om Śrī Gaṇeśaya Namaḥ**
4. The ritual can be performed on Mahāmeru or on a Śrī Yantra created on a metal plate.
5. Say your sankalpa (intention) to Vārāhī Devī to whom you dedicate the ritual.
6. Perform abhiṣekam 108 times with pañcāmṛta/milk poured in Her place in yantra, with a spoon or touching this spot with a flower dipped in pañcāmṛta/milk.
7. The ritual is performed with the right hand.
8. After completing the ritual, do the namaskaram to the yantra and Guruji.
9. The ritual is recommended to be performed for 44 days.
10. Afterwards mantra-charged pañcāmṛta/milk that was used in the ritual can be:
  - consumed,
  - used in cooking, or
  - poured on yourself in the bath to enhance the effect.
